## JOETEN-KIYU PUBLIC LIBRARY HOSTS SUCCESSFUL NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK PROCLAMATION SIGNING AND LITERACY BLOCK PARTY IN APRIL



The Joeten-Kiyu Public Library proudly hosted a vibrant and inspiring National Library Week Proclamation Signing and Literacy Block Party on Saturday, April 5, 2025, drawing over 1,429 community members to celebrate the power of libraries in education, connection, and lifelong learning. The event featured proclamations recognizing National Library Week, National Library Outreach Day, and National Library Worker's Day, as well as remarks from local leaders, including First Lady Wella Palacios, who spoke passionately about the theme "Drawn to Your Library." Families enjoyed a festive block party filled with cultural performances, educational booths, petting zoos, carnival games, and more. The program was livestreamed on the Marianas Agupa Show Chamorro News, extending its reach to audiences across the CNMI and Guam.



A highlight of the event was the unveiling of the A&E plans for JKPL's 174kW Solar PV Carport Project, made possible through \$1.6 million in federal earmark funding secured by U.S. Congressman Gregorio "Kilili" Camacho Sablan. This sustainability initiative is expected to save the library over \$100,000 annually in energy costs. The celebration also included special tributes to the late Commonwealth Library Council Chairman George Norita Camacho, recognition of 2025 Employee of the Year Leoralynn Sablan Terlaje and Leadership Awardee Beth Barcinas Demapan, and heartfelt thanks to volunteers, partners, and Educational Tax Credit donors. The event truly reflected the strength of community collaboration and the library's continued commitment to literacy, innovation, and inclusive service to all.
